- The MC4BSM map: <http://tinyurl.com/y2mxoty>
- Some attractions are listed (bottom left)
 - Statens Museum for kunst: Big art museum. Large selection
 - Ny Carlsberg Glyptotek: Fantastic building in its own right, classical art collection (think Roman statues)
 - Assistens kirkegård: A cemetery turned into a park. Niels Bohr is buried here.
 - Rosenborg slot: Pretty little castle. The crown jewels are here
 - Christiansborg slot: Parliament. The cellars also shows the ruins of earlier incarnations of the castle.

Suggestion

- 11:00 Meet at the entrance to Rosenborg (that's when they open)
