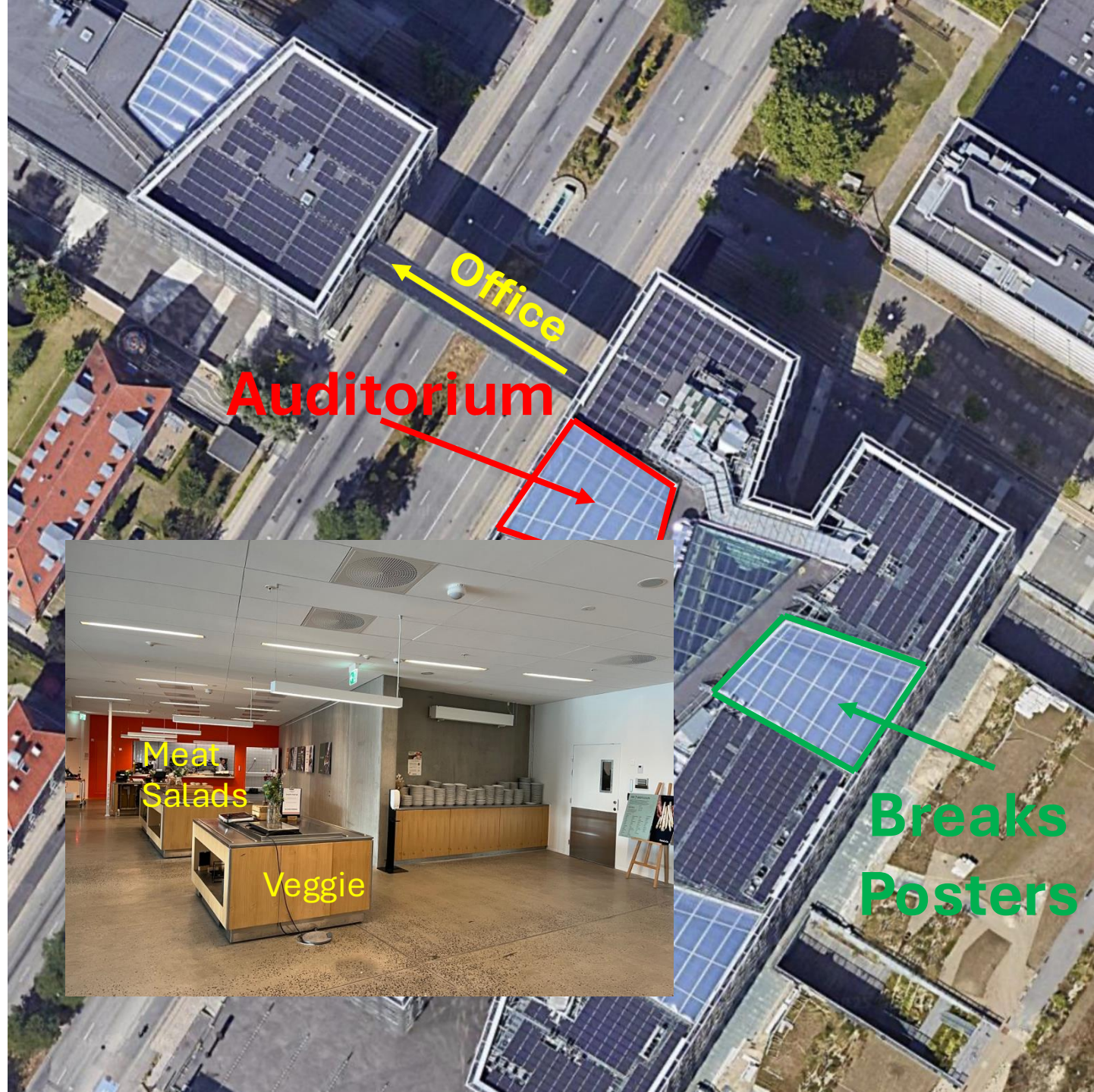
Overview

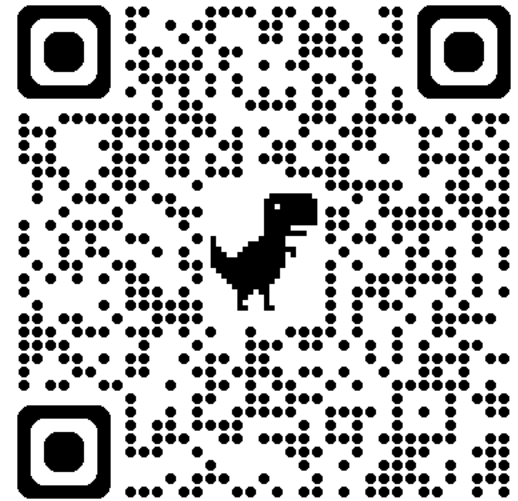

- We will share all talks with conference participants only, and ask for your consent beforehand



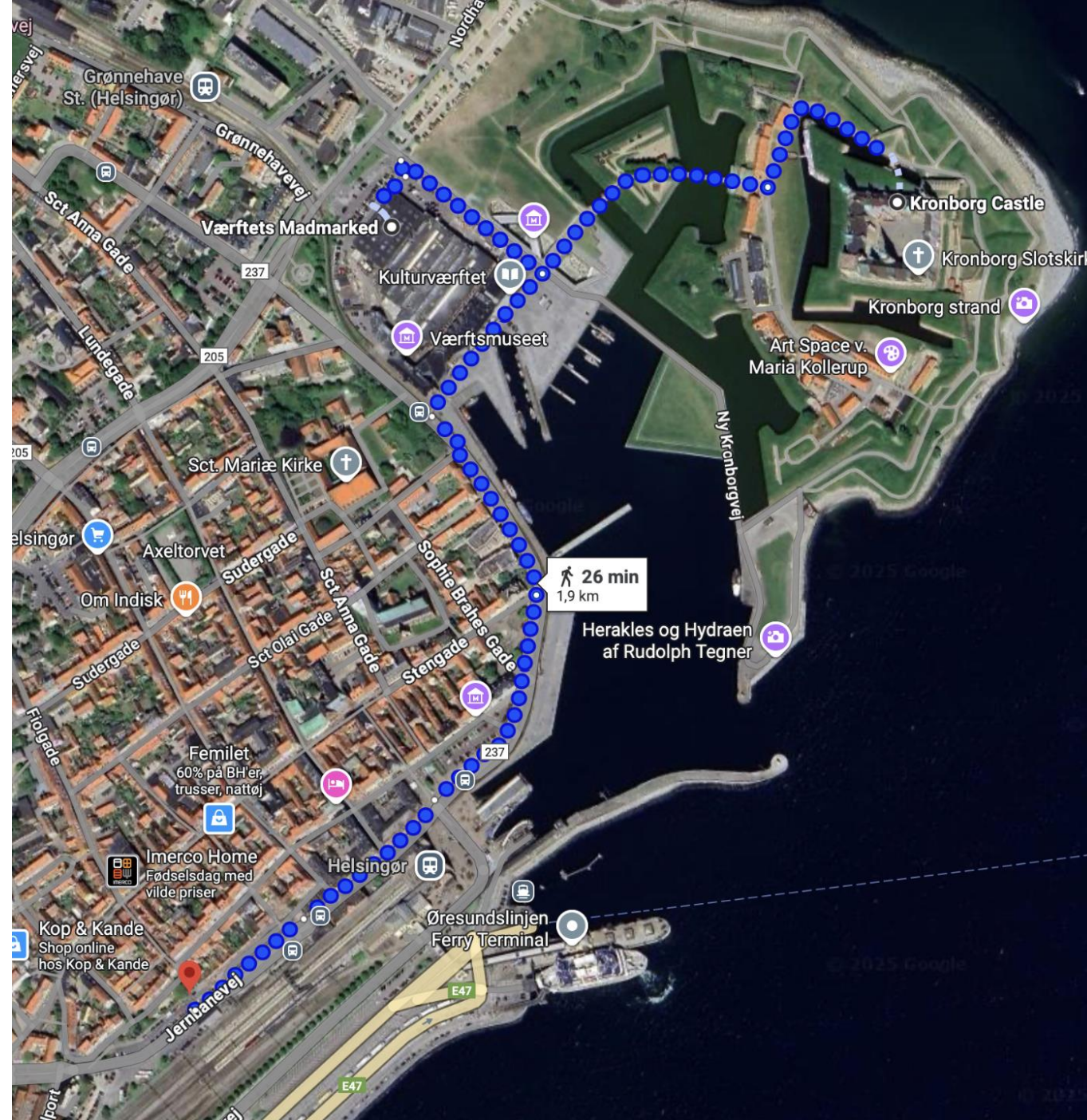
Plan for Helsingør
