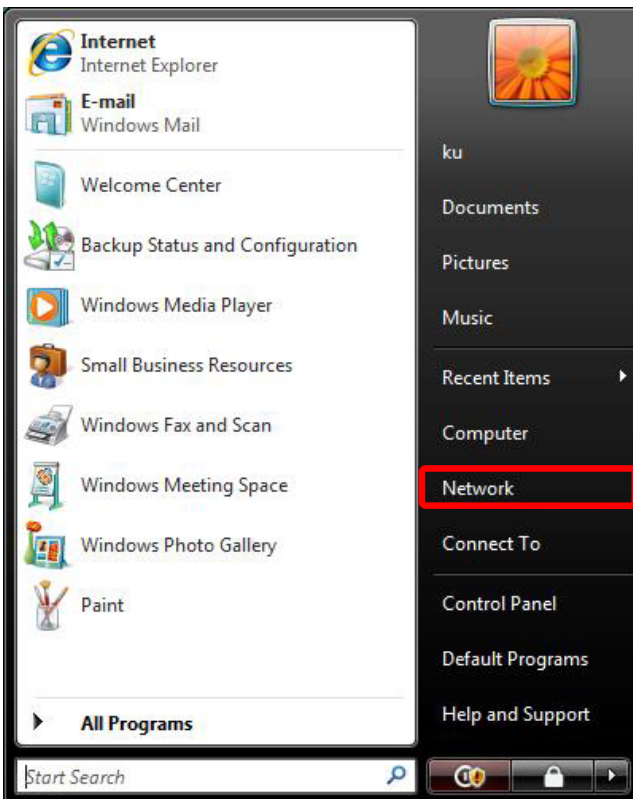
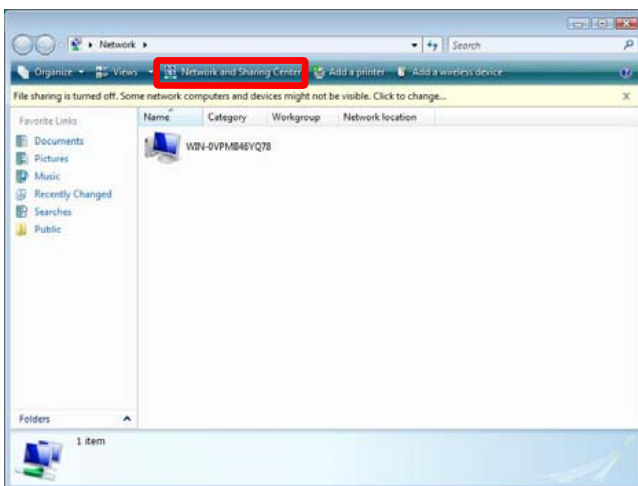


Eduroam configuration for Windows Vista

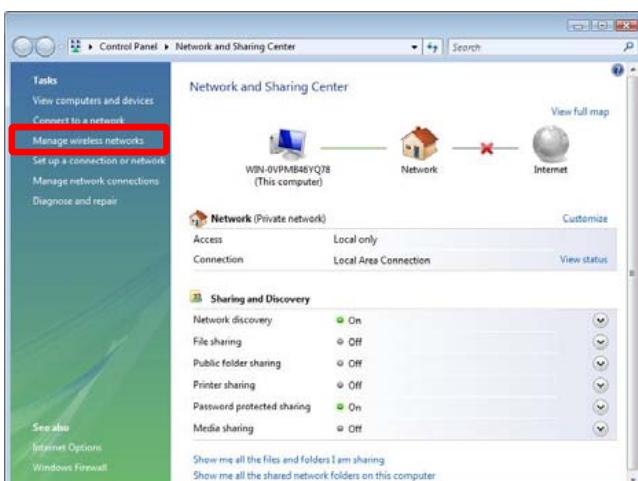


This is the guide for setting up a wireless eduroam connection on your laptop. Please follow the guide step-by-step for a flawless setup.

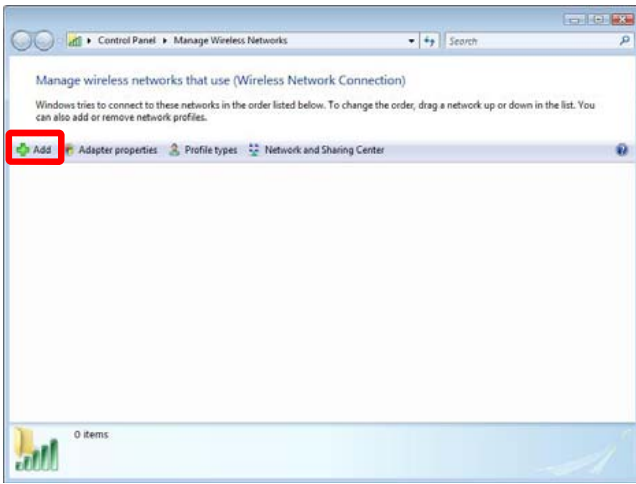
Open the start menu and choose **'Network'**



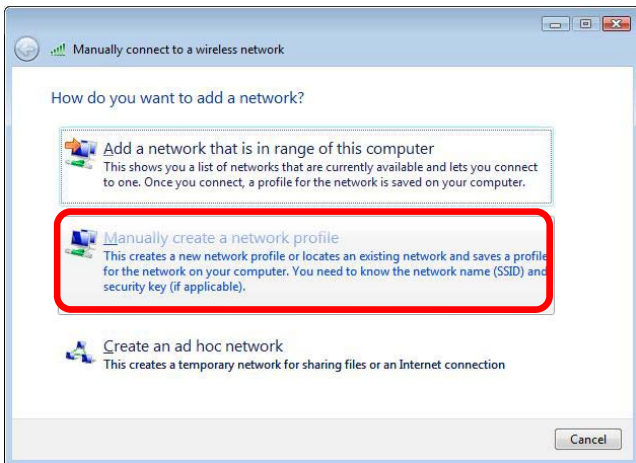
Choose the tab **'Network and sharing center'**



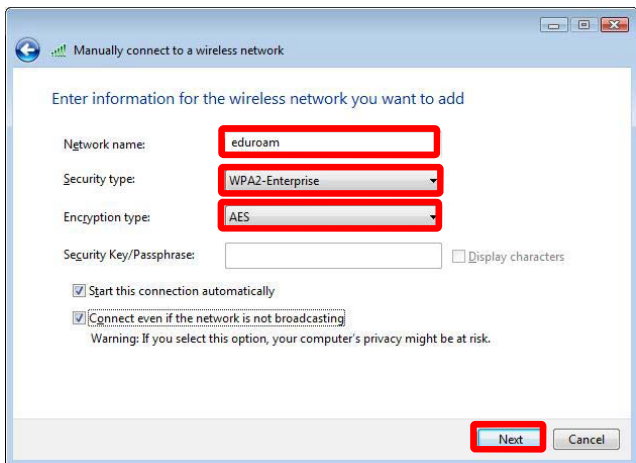
Click on **'Manage wireless networks'**



Click on '**Add**'



And choose '**Manually create a network profile**'



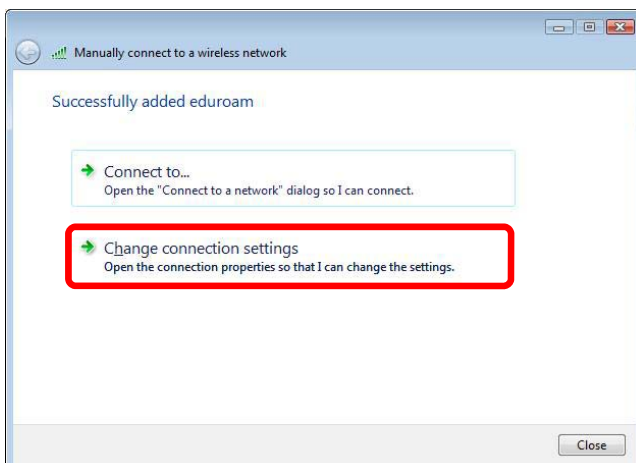
In the field '*Network Name*' type in:

eduroam

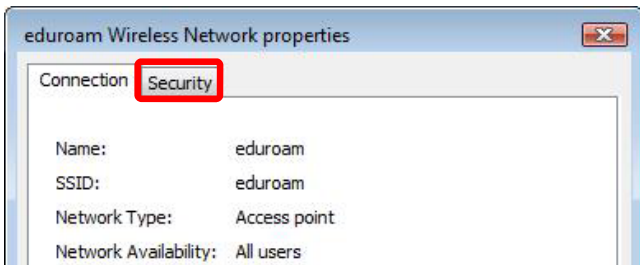
Choose security type: **WPA2-enterprise**

Encryption type: **AES**

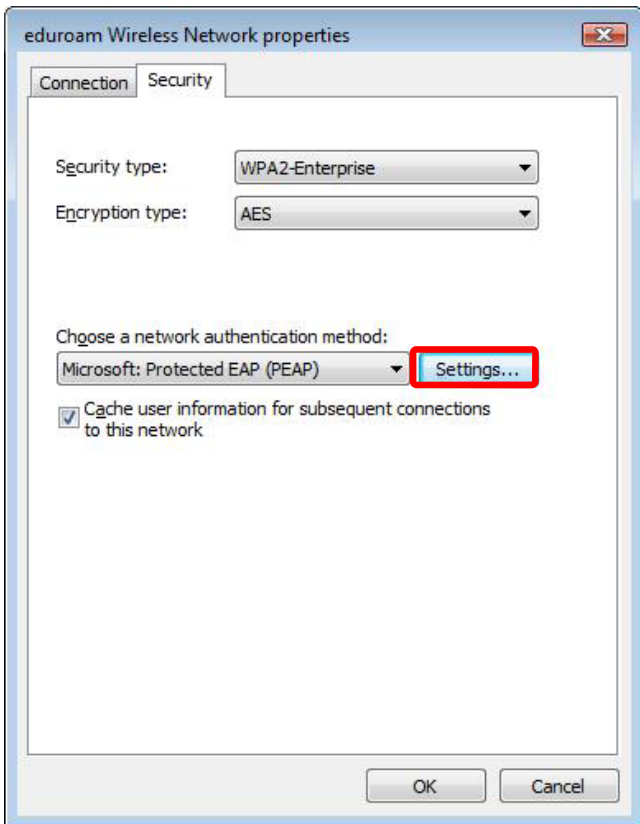
Click '**Next**'



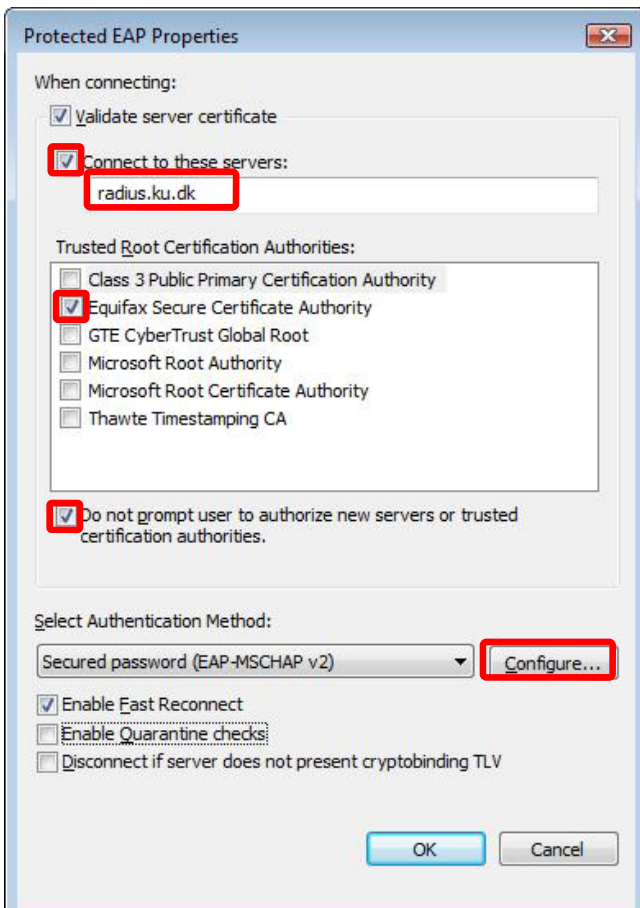
Click '**Change connection settings**'



Choose the **Security** tab



And click on '**Settings...**'



Tick the box '**Connect to these servers**'

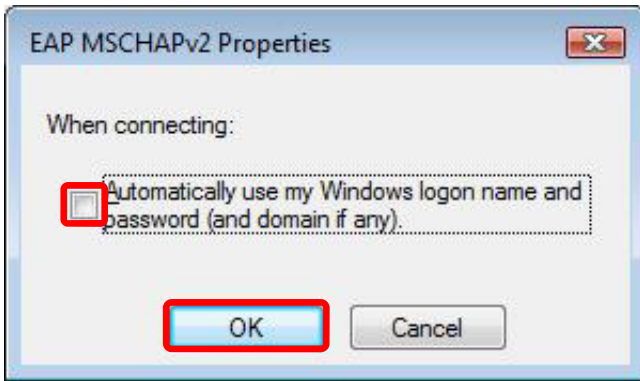
And type in **radius.ku.dk**

Tick the box '**Equifax Secure Certificate Authority**'

*If this is the first time you are setting up a connection to eduroam you may not have the certificate '**Equifax Secure Certificate Authority**'*

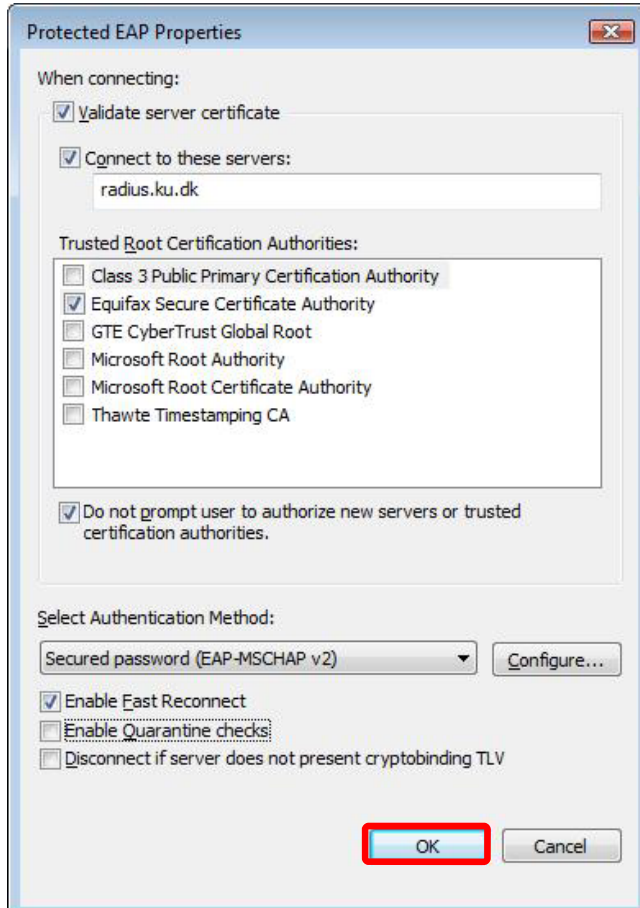
*In this case, you do not need to tick any boxes in the '**Trusted Root Certification Authorities**'*

Click '**Configure...**'

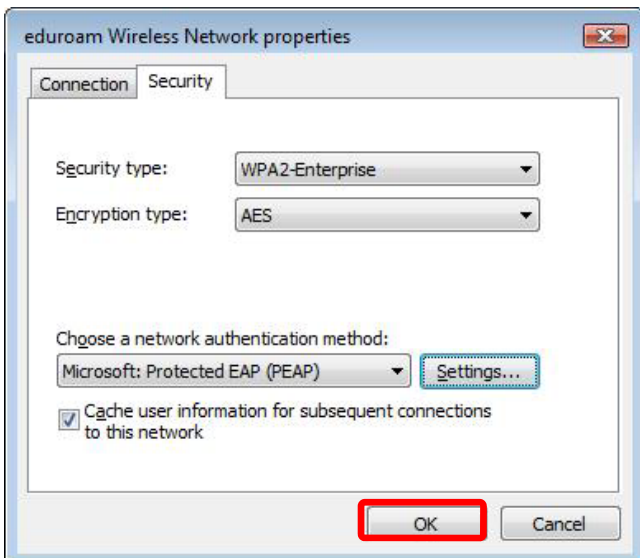


Make sure the box '*Automatically use my Windows logon name and password*' is **unticked**.

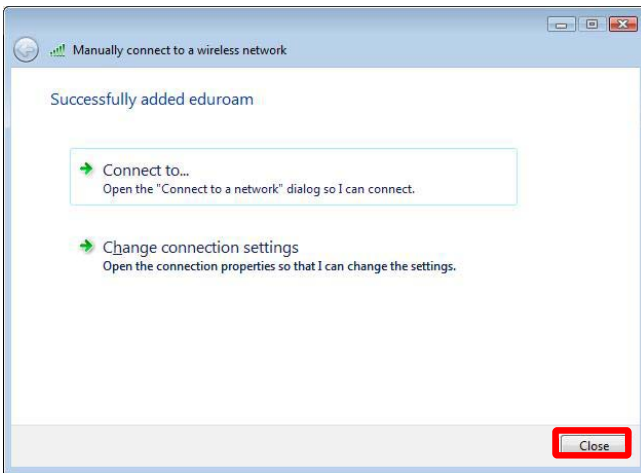
Click '**OK**'



Click '**OK**'



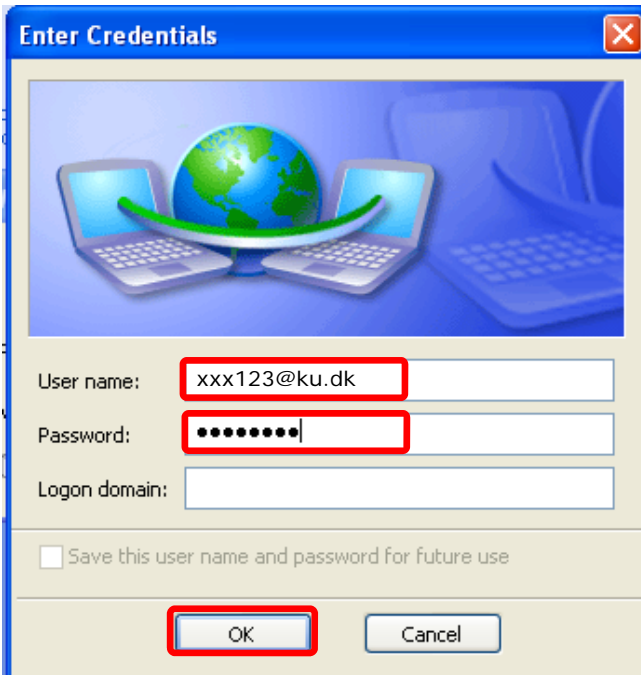
Click '**OK**'

You will now be prompted for your User name and Password.



It is important that you use your **UCPH-username** followed by **@ku.dk**

And your **UCPH-password**

Please note that the Logon domain field should remain empty
